3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 2500 characters)

The decision to eliminate this project and reallocate the funds in this year's competition was made by the project sponsor/applicant, The Housing Authority of Durham (DHA). The CoC Lead Agency had expressed concerns about the project's performance in recent years to DHA. Two concerns were that new project participants were not receiving housing search assistance that the project applications indicated that participants would receive and that, more generally, the DHA was not ensuring that voluntary supportive services were available to all project participants. With DHA going through significant organizational changes as it uses Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) conversions to rehabilitate many of its public housing communities, DHA determined that it did not have the capacity at this time to manage this small PSH project. The CoC Lead Agency was notified of DHA's decision on June 6, 2022. DHA has committed to transitioning all current Home Again participants to other tenant-based voucher projects, e.g. Housing Choice Vouchers, in the final year of Home Again's CoC-funding, & the CoC will work with DHA and other community service providers to ensure that any Home Again participants continue to receive the supportive services they need to maintain permanent housing.

3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 2500 characters)

The project applicant, the Durham Crisis Response Center (DCRC), voluntarily decided to eliminate this project and reallocate these funds. DCRC is the CoC's only Victim Service Provider dedicated to serving the needs of survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, etc. When DCRC initially applied for a Domestic Violence Bonus project in 2018, we and HUD were assured that the organization, as a VSP, did have a database comparable to an HMIS that would be used to track the participants in the DV Bonus project and provide the required reports to HUD and the CoC. However, as we and HUD have seen, DCRC is still in the process in 2022 of "standing up" a comparable database! In addition, since 2018, DCRC has gone through several executive leadership transitions. The interim executive director (ED) who submitted the original 2018 project application left the organization shortly after a permanent ED was hired in early 2019. That ED left the organization in late 2020 or early 2021. The organization has had two interim EDs since then and brought on a new permanent ED in the summer of 2022. In light of the challenges associated with getting a comparable database operational and the organization's staffing capacities, an interim ED decided that DCRC would relinquish this CoC grant voluntarily in the 2022 competition and informed the CoC Lead Agency and the CoC's Performance Management Committee on April 14, 2022.
