Teams of youth volunteers will be talking to youth between the ages of 16 to 25 in various locations in Durham so that we can better understand their housing experiences. The teams will survey youth on January 28 and January 29 between the hours of 1 PM and 8 PM. Volunteers may choose from four 3 ½ hour volunteer shifts!

The count is a vital component for ensuring the well-being of young people experiencing housing instability in Durham and better understanding the housing and service needs of these young people.

The Count

Teams conducting this count will be 2-3 young adults, ages 17-25, accompanied by another adult. Teams may be accompanied by law enforcement. Teams will be assigned to a specific area of the community, e.g. the Southpoint Mall. Volunteers will approach people who appear to be under age 26 and ask them to complete a brief, online survey about themselves and their housing. Volunteers administer surveys and distribute donated items to survey respondents to thank them for their participation.
